

HSI Skillko is becoming HSI Donesafe on April 14th 2026

What this means for you

From April 14th 2026, the HSI Skillko platform will transition to HSI Donesafe.

This follows Skillko becoming part of HSI in 2024 and reflects the next step in aligning platforms and bringing capabilities together under a broader EHS offering.

There is no change to how you use the platform today. Your existing workflows, data, and access will remain the same.

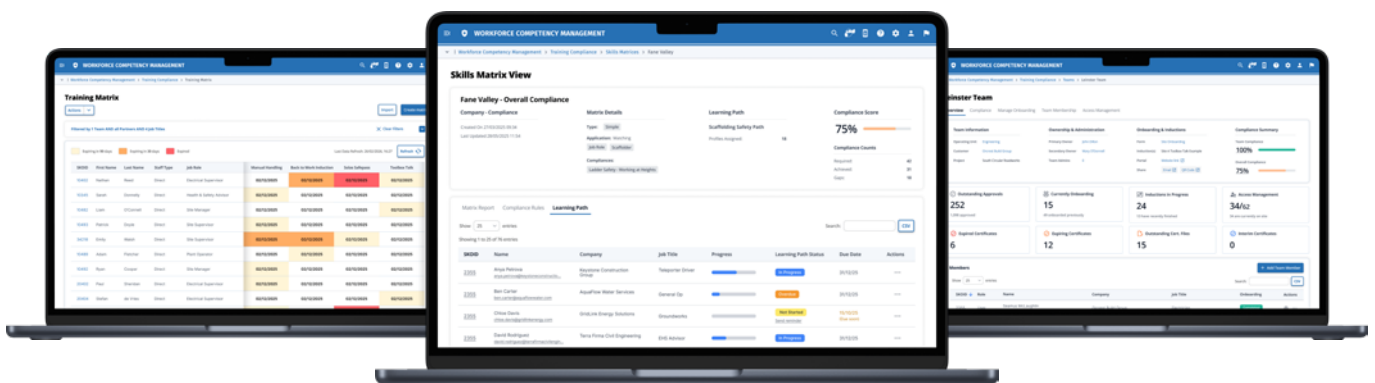
When you log in, you will notice updated branding. The platform will no longer display the HSI Skillko name.

What will the platform look like?

All existing functionality will remain the same.

The HSI Skillko logo will be replaced with the HSI logo, and the platform will be renamed as our Workforce Competency Management solution.

You will also see updated brand colours across the platform.



What's not changing?

- All existing functionality
- Your login details and access
- Your data, records, and workflows
- How you manage training, competency, and compliance

What's changing?

- The name HSI Skillko will no longer be used in the platform
- Updated logo and brand colours
- New naming: Workforce Competency Management
- The HSI Skillko website will be retired

Why this change is happening

Since Skillko joined HSI in 2024, work has been underway to align platforms and bring capabilities together in a more consistent way.

Moving to the HSI Donesafe brand reflects this progress and provides a clearer structure for how workforce competency sits alongside HSI's broader EHS platform.

HSI Donesafe provides a broader EHS management platform, bringing together safety, compliance, and workforce capabilities within a single system. By bringing HSI Skillko and HSI Donesafe together, workforce competency, compliance, and safety can be managed in one place, from onboarding through to audit and ongoing compliance.
